



Roger M. Sullivan

August 21, 1925 - May 12, 2015

Roger Michael Sullivan, 89 passed away Tuesday, May 12th at his home near Doniphan.

Mass of Christian Burial will be 11 a.m. Friday at St. Ann's Catholic Church at Doniphan. His son, Father John Sullivan will celebrate mass. Burial will be in the Cedarview Cemetery followed by military honors.

Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. Thursday, at St. Ann's Catholic Church with recitation of the Rosary at 7 p.m. All Faiths Funeral Home of Grand Island is serving the family.

Roger was born August 21, 1925 near Doniphan. Roger attended a one-room country grade school then Doniphan High School from which he graduated in 1944. Following graduation, Roger served in the U.S. Army as part of the invasion of Normandy in 1944 and was part of the D-Day landing operation at Omaha Beach. Roger served throughout the remainder of World War II in the European Theatre until he was honorably discharged.

He returned from the Army to Doniphan to continue farming and raising livestock. Roger married Berniece Nissen in June of 1949 at St. Ann's Catholic Church, Doniphan. Roger continued to farm until his retirement. Roger was a member of St. Ann's Catholic Church, the Saddle Club, and American Legion, Platt Deutsche, Cedarview Cemetery Board and various other organizations.

He was preceded in death by his wife Berniece; daughter Karen Clausen; parents, Eugene and Iva (Kingston) Sullivan; in-laws, Fred and Edith (Watson)

Nissen; brothers/sister-in-laws Richard (Vivian) Sullivan, Patrick (Claire) Sullivan, John Sullivan and brother-in-law Virgil Nissen.

Survivors of the immediate family are his son Mark (Karen) Sullivan, Doniphan; son-in-law Kenny Clausen, Grand Island; daughter Peg (Ron) Schoen, Lincoln; son Tim (Mary Clare) Sullivan, Lincoln; daughter Patty (Brett) Coleman, Plattsmouth; son, Father John Sullivan, Lincoln; sister-in-law Milrae Sullivan, Grand Island; eleven grand-children; five great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
