Roland Britton, 89, of Grand Island died on Thursday, May 8, 2014.

To honor his wishes, cremation has taken place, and there will be no visitation. Private family burial of ashes will be in the West Lawn Memorial Cemetery. All Faiths Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.

Survivors include his wife, Elsie Britton of Grand Island, and son, Randall Britton of St. Louis, MO.

He is preceded in death by his parents.

Mr. Britton was born on March 6, 1925 at Taylor, to Tim and Hazel (Lundy) Britton. He attended and graduated from Loup County High School at Taylor. After graduation he helped his parents on their ranch and shortly after graduation he entered the Armed Services in March of 1943. After basic training at Fort Knox, KY he was attached to the 787th Tank Battalion which was part of General Mark Clark's 5th Army in Italy. He served honorably and was discharged in June of 1946.

He married Elsie D. Klapal in 1950 and in 1953 their only son Randall was born.

They lived in Sargent, several years managing a business. Later they moved to Lincoln, where he attended business college, and subsequently moved to Grand Island. He was employed by a Certified Accounting firm for several years before retiring in 1985.

He enjoyed fishing and hunting, and traveling with his family.

He was a member of the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Platt-

Duetsche and Trinity United Methodist Church.
