Ronald W. Carlson, 84 of Grand Island died on Monday, April 13, 2020 at CHI Health-St. Francis.

He entered the US Army on October 5, 1956, and honorably discharged on October 3, 1958.

On November 15, 1959 he was united in marriage to Betty Ostrander. They moved to Grand Island in 1972. Ronald worked for 12 years at COOP Creamery in Fullerton and farmed for almost 61 years. They are members of First Faith United Methodist Church. Ronald and Betty enjoyed buying and selling different collectables.
