Ronald D. Porter, 84, of Grand Island, passed away at his home surrounded by his family on Sunday, November 13, 2022, after battling a long illness. 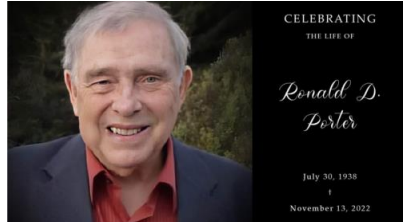
