Ronald Reinhardt Quandt, 92, of Grand Island, passed away on July 23, 2025 at CHI- Health St. Francis. A funeral service is scheduled for Tuesday, July 29th at 10:30 am at Trinity Lutheran Church with Reverend Adam Snoberger officiating. Burial will follow at the Wiegert Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Monday, July 28th from 5-7 pm at All Faiths Funeral Home.
