Ronald C. Shullaw, 72 of Doniphan, died Saturday, July 12, 2014 at Tiffany Square after a courageous four and a half year battle with Multiple Myeloma and Plasma Cell Leukemia.

Services will be 10 a.m. Thursday at All Faiths Funeral Home in Grand Island. Dan Naranjo will officiate.

Entombment will be in the Wyuka Cemetery at Lincoln at 3 p.m. Thursday with military honors provided by the U.S. Marine Corp.
