Local businessman and storyteller, Russell Crooks, 75, passed away on Friday, December 30, 2022, of heart failure. A native of California, Russell moved with his family to Grand Island in 1992. Following a 35-year career as an engineering manager for the Federal Aviation Administration, he retired to join his wife in the antiques business, where he became known as the “Light Guy” in Downtown Grand Island, as he specialized in the restoration of antique lights and fans.
