Scott Thomas Panagiotis, 51, of Iowa, passed away on Easter morning, April 17, 2022 in Charles City, Iowa. He later earned four Six Sigma Black Belt Certifications in Project Management.

His career as a Pharmaceutical Consultant and a Quality Assurance Manager took him all over the world including Russia, Belgium, Switzerland, Germany, Italy, India, and China. He worked for the Federal Drug Administration as an Investigator, Drug Specialist. He also worked for Novartis Consumer Health, Par Pharmaceutical, Nova-Tech, Inc., Pennfield Animal Health, as well as owning and managing his own LLC since 2010 where his career led him to oversee the Covid-19 Vaccine Drug Substance testing for Johnson and

Johnson. Most recently, he worked for Zoetis Pharmaceuticals in Charles City, IA. He was held in high esteem by colleagues and well known for his professional knowledge and expertise.

Scott united in marriage to Manlei Wang on January 18, 2016, in Wu Han, China. The couple moved from China to New Jersey and New York in 2017. They moved to Grand Island, NE in 2019. Then to Charles City in 2022. In his spare time, Scott enjoyed being with his wife, biking, movie watching, and play time with Hunter (Guys) their Parti Yorkie dog. Scott adored people and cherished his relationships with his family and friends all over the world.
