



Sharon (Sheere') Ruth Gleason

April 10, 1938 - February 8, 2025

Sharon (Sheere') Ruth Gleason, age 86, passed away on February 8, 2025, at the Kansas Christian Home in Newton, Kansas. She was born on April 10, 1938, in Hastings, Nebraska, to Roy and Doris (Nelson) Bassett.

Sheere' grew up in Hastings, attending Longfellow Elementary and Hastings Junior High, graduating from Hastings High School in 1956.

After attending Hastings College for one year studying Christian Education, she moved to Hollywood, California, to pursue another passion, dance.

Sheere' enrolled in the American School of Dance on Hollywood Boulevard. She returned to Hastings in 1962 and began teaching dance to students of all ages throughout mid-Nebraska. Her career as a dance instructor and choreographer lasted for almost 70 years, most of that time being in Grand Island at the YWCA. Sheere' taught hundreds of dance students and loved it!

Sheere' was united in marriage to Stephen Lawrence Gleason on June 22, 1963. After living in Omaha and Kearney, they moved to Grand Island in 1966. For the next 55 years, they made Grand Island their home and served the community in many ways. They were best friends, supportive of one another always, and loved each other dearly until Steve passed away on January 5, 2019, at Edgewood Memory Care in Grand Island. They were both active members of Trinity United Methodist Church serving in many capacities

including teaching Sunday school for many years. They also attended St. Mary's Cathedral and raised their four children in both churches. Their Christian faith was strong and evident by the way they cared for others throughout their many years of marriage.

Sheere' is survived by her son Steve and wife Michele (Bochnicek), her son Scott and wife Ondria (Oberg), her son Bob and wife Mindy (Klassen), and daughter Christy Lane. She is also survived by her grandchildren Stephanie, Brandon, Bradley, Melissa, Zachary, Sam, Alex, Luke, and Jake, great-grandchildren Charlotte, Osiris, Jocelyn, Juliette, and Alaina and her brother Tom Bassett and wife Karen of Lincoln, Nebraska.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, and an infant granddaughter, Samantha.

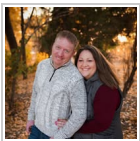

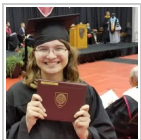
