When she was 10 years old her and her family returned to Nebraska to live closer to her mother's side of the family. She finished elementary and middle school in Chapman, NE. in 2019. This was one of her proudest moments and something she worked hard for and that really showed that if Shawnee wanted to do something there was nothing anyone could say or do to stop her. She was the smallest immovable force in the world.

“ I met Shawnee completely at random. I was out with a friend and this beautiful girl came up and told me she loved my tattoos and I told her I loved hers also. We talked for a bit and she took my phone and added herself on all of my social media. We didn't talk all the time, but we talked here and there. Then I found out I was pregnant. Shawnee was one of the first people to stick by me. She checked in on me, showed up for me, and when someone openly talked negatively about me and my pregnancy she defended me. On some random weekday I bumped into her at Five Below and she was so excited because earlier that morning she'd gone to A Higher Plane and found a crystal that made her think of me and had gotten it for me. Without knowing what I liked, she found the exact perfect thing. That crystal has sat on display with all of my pretty things and collectibles since she gave it to me. During my second and third trimester, I went to karaoke regularly and Shawnee was always there. She would dance with me, talk to my belly, sit by me, laugh with me. She called me her “goth baby” and it was sweet and funny. Near the end of my pregnancy she used to come up behind me and hold my tummy up to relieve some of the pressure on my back. She came to my baby shower and signed a onesie for my son, talked about all of the things we were going to do and how our kids would be friends. When my son was born she checked in on me regularly and despite my having postpartum depression she never stopped being my friend, even when I stopped communicating with everyone around me. Shawnee was one of a kind and such a sweet soul. She was easy to talk to, fun to spill tea with, and ferociously protective of her friends and loved ones. She loved her daughter so, so much. Shawnee spent her time actively showing up for her friends and loving them no matter what, even through a distance. I will always regret that when my mental health tanked I didn't talk to her as much anymore but I will NEVER regret meeting her, getting to know her, being her friend, loving her. Those are all things I will cherish for the rest of my life.

Shawnee, I miss you. I'll miss you forever. You are so, so incredibly loved and someday we'll dance and sing together again. Someday.

None of us will ever forget you, you truly made an impact on those that love you. I'm so incredibly sad that you're gone, it breaks my heart. But I'm so joyful I got to be your friend. How lucky am I to have had that honor? Love you so much babygirl. Rest easy. 💖
