Stanley J. "Jim" Grudzinski, 74, of St. Libory, passed from this life on Tuesday, January 26, 2016.

Stan was an avid Husker fan and his other enjoyments included fishing, camping, caring for his roses and reading westerns and the newspapers. He also loved music and singing and going to dances with his wife. Stan's grandchildren meant the world to him, and his family will miss his teasing and
