Stanley Neil "Stan" Mengers, 76, of Grand Island passed away on June 3, 2019.

Memorial service and celebration of Stan's life will be at 1:00 p.m. Monday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Dan Naranjo will officiate. A gathering of family and friends will be from 12:00 until service time. Burial of ashes will be in Westlawn Memorial Park Cemetery.

Stan was born November 23, 1942 in Phillips County, Kansas, to Vaughan and Anna (Ruhl) Mengers. He attended Naponee High School and Kearney State College. After college Stan trucked for Mengers Trucking.

On December 30, 1982, Stan married Joanne Peacock in the Grand Island Trinity United Methodist Church. Over the years he worked for Missouri Valley Construction and then for Western Engineering Construction Company for 25 years. He was currently employed by Gary Smith Construction.
