August 6, 1946 - January 24, 2024

Stephen "Steve" LeRoy Bennett, age 77, of Alda passed away on Wednesday, January 24, 2024.

There will be a memorial service and celebration of Steve's life held at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, February 1st, at All Faiths Funeral Home with Daniel Naranjo officiating. Steve's ashes will be entombed at Grand Island City Cemetery with military honors provided by the United States Army and the Grand Island Honor Guard.

A gathering of family and friends will be held at the funeral home from 12:30 until the time of the service.

Steve was born August 6, 1946, in Grand Island, the son of Rufus "Johnny" and Katherine (Brown) Bennett. He grew up in Grand Island and enlisted in the United States Army on March 6, 1964, at age 18 and was honorably discharged March 9, 1968. He remained with the National Guard for another 12 years.

On April 14, 1973, Steve married Carol Condry. He made his career as a diesel mechanic and retired as service manager at Bosselman's.

A 'jack of all trades and master of some', Steve was an inventor of sorts, and could patch together whatever it was that needed repaired. He enjoyed art and was very artistic. He also enjoyed western movies, watching NCIS, visiting with friends, and was a history buff. Above all, Steve was always there for his family. He loved his children and grandchildren dearly.

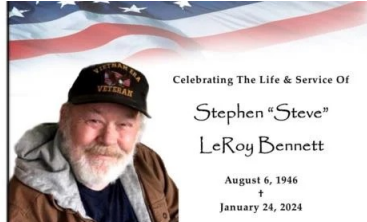
