Stephen 'Steve' E. Hansen, 89 of Grand Island went to his Heavenly home peacefully on Monday, June 30, 2025.

Steve was born on June 26, 1936 in Holstein, IA, son of Wilbur and Jeanette (Ellington) Hansen. Following his father's death while Steve was a small child, the family moved to Grand Island. Steve was a Grand Island Senior High Graduate with the class of 1954 and earned his business degree from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln, in 1959.

On December 6, 1963 he married Judy Leep. They made their home in Grand Island and raised their family. Out of college, Steve joined the truck division of International Harvester as an area sales manager and in 1973 he purchased the Grand Island branch. Hansen International Truck was established in December of 1973. He retired in 1999 with his son, Stephen taking over the company.

Steve was a member and served as the president of both the Hall County Livestock Association (Fonner Park) and Riverside Golf Club. He served as a member of the Board of Directors of the Nebraska Golf Association (NGA). Upon retirement, he became a member of the Platte Duestche, where daily he could be found playing cards and having drinks with some of his best friends. When Steve wasn't golfing and playing cards, he was attending family events. He loved all the grandkid birthdays, golf tournaments and holidays.

He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Judy Hansen; children, Julie (Tim) Johnson of Broken Bow, and Stephen P. (Kelly) Hansen of Grand Island; grandchildren, Taylor (Josh) Arnold, Tanner Johnson, Abbey Hansen and Kenzie Hansen; great-granddaughters, Anniston, Tilly and Leni Arnold; many nieces and nephews.
