Tammy Kay Serr, 56, of Dannebrog, Nebraska, passed away February 24, 2023 after a battle with ALS (Lou Gehrig's disease) that was diagnosed July 2022. Tammy was surrounded by her family and passed away peacefully during the night. Tammy was born on July 28th, 1966, in Grand Island, NE to Eddie and Shirley Boltz (Maddox). She graduated from Centura High School in 1984 and moved to Austin, TX where she met her husband Robert. On May 1st, 1993, she married Robert Serr of Butte Falls, Oregon and together they have three children: Nick, Benjamin and Emily.

Robert and Tammy resided in Austin, TX for 13 years where their 2 oldest children were born before moving back to Dannebrog, NE, where their youngest was born. Tammy loved to talk about the kids at the school visiting her to get candy and stickers. After her time as a librarian, she took her passion for children to ABC Daycare in Cairo, NE. She also enjoyed arts & crafts, playing cards with friends, photography, and most of all spending time with family and friends.
