



## Terry L Kaczor

October 27, 1949 - January 5, 2022

Terry L. Kaczor, 72, of Grand Island passed away on Wednesday, January 5, 2022 at Mary Lanning Hospital in Hastings.

Services in Terry's honor will be held at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, January 12, 2022 at Trinity Lutheran Church. Pastor Adam Snoberger will officiate. Private family burial will be held at Spencer Cemetery in Spencer, NE.

Terry was born on October 27, 1949 in Lynch, NE, son of Elmer and Ruby (Mott) Kaczor.

He attended District #52 country school until the 8th grade. Terry graduated from Spencer High School in 1968. Growing up on the family farm north of Spencer, Terry helped with feeding the chickens, milking the cows before school, hog chores and feeding the cattle. When caring for his own family farm he also helped his neighbors.

Terry continued his education and graduated from Milford College in 1970. He began employment with Case New Holland out of college and retired in 2012. He was an active member of Trinity Lutheran Church volunteering as an usher for many years.

On June 14, 1980 he married Dori Schmidt, they made their home in Grand Island and were blessed with a daughter, Lindsey.

Fishing and hunting were life long passions for Terry. Starting with fishing in

the cattle pond in walking distance and family deer hunting trips. As he got older, Terry never missed a chance to fish for Northern Pike near Gross. There were even a few trips out west to hunt elk and antelope. After the hunting was finished, Terry would usually get stuck smoking the bologna and summer sausage. He enjoyed camping with family and friends that will always cherish the time they spent at the lake with him.

He is survived by his wife, Dori of Grand Island; daughter, Lindsey (Scott) Huss; grandchildren, Ali and Conner; brothers, Fred (Colleen) Kaczor of Spencer and Jody (Colene) Kaczor of Spencer; sisters, Trudy (Ken) Boettcher of Spencer and Peggy Jackson (Dwayne Kobza) of St. Paul; brothers-in-law, Darrell (Jean Anne) Schmidt of Hampton, Elroy (Joan) Schmidt of Grand Island, and Richard (Marlene) Schmidt of Grand Island; sister-in-law, Norma (Max) Diggs of Fairmont, NE; and a host of aunts, nieces and nephews.
