



## Thomas J. Corkle

August 24, 1942 - January 17, 2019

Thomas J. Corkle, 76, of Grand Island passed away on Thursday, January 17, 2019 at Tiffany Square Care Center.

Visitation will be from 5 to 7 on Sunday, January 20, 2019 at All Faiths Funeral Home, with a prayer service at 7 pm.

Mass of Christian Burial will be held 10:30 am on Monday, January 21, 2019 at St. Mary's Cathedral, with celebrant Fr. Ryan. Burial to follow at Grand Island City Cemetery.

Tom was born on August 24, 1942 at Norfolk, NE, son of John Sr. and Mabel (Daly) Corkle.

He grew up near Tilden, NE and graduated from High School at Neligh. Tom continued his education, graduating from both University of Nebraska at Lincoln and Colorado School of Banking at Boulder.

On May 30, 1970 he married Anita Deckert. This union was blessed with three children. They made their home in Grand Island where Tom was employed by Commercial National Bank, Northwest National Bank, Five Points Bank, and finally retiring from Heritage Bank in Grand Island/Doniphan in 2009.

Tom was a devoted member of St. Mary's Cathedral. He also held memberships with the Kiwanis Club, Saddle Club, the Hall County Historical Society, and the Chamber of Commerce Ag Committee.
