Thomas F. Eisenmenger, 70, of Grand Island passed away peacefully at home on Saturday, November 30, 2019.

Mass of Christian burial will be 10:00 a.m. Wednesday at St. Leo's Catholic Church. The celebrant is Father Don Buhrman.

Visitation is from 4-6 p.m. Tuesday at the church with a Rosary at 6:00. All Faiths Funeral Home is entrusted with the arrangements.

Thomas was born on December 10, 1948 in Vermillion, S.D. to Paul and Robin (Ballard) Eisenmenger. He grew up on the farm near Vermillion, receiving his education in the Vermillion Public School. He attended the University of South Dakota and graduated with a BA in 1971. Thomas was a teacher in Atkinson, NE and a principal at York St. Joseph's.
