Thomas E. "Tom" Moran, 74, of Grand Island died on Wednesday, March 8, 2017.

Service and celebration of Tom's life will be at 2:00 p.m. Saturday at True North Church, 1804 W. State Street, Grand Island.

To honor Tom's wishes, cremation has taken place. All Faiths Funeral Home is serving the family.

Tom was born March 1, 1943, in Wellsboro, Pennsylvania to Harry and Pauline (Matteson) Moran. He graduated from Mansfield High School, Pennsylvania, Class of 1961 and immediately joined the Army. Tom served from September 1961 to September 1964. On September 21, 1979 he married his soul mate, Sue Rasmussen, in Trinity United Methodist Church.
