Thomas Glenn Townsley, Jr., 84, of Grand Island, passed away on November 28, 2025, at CHI Health St. Francis. Celebration of Life services will be held at a later date. All Faiths Funeral Home is entrusted with arrangements.

Tom was born on August 9, 1941 in Aurora, to Thomas and Marie (Bearnth) Townsley, Sr. He entered the Air Force after graduating from Aurora High School in 1959. In the Air Force he was a fighter jet mechanic, and was honorably discharged in 1964.

On July 18, 1960, Tom was united in marriage to Barbara Sue Nutter. Following their marriage they lived in Grand Island for a short time while Tom was away in the Air Force. When he was stationed in Kansas, the couple made their home there for several years before moving to Washington for one year and then back to Grand Island. After the Air Force, Tom worked in Kansas as a Boeing Airplane Sheet Metal Mechanic. In WA, he worked for Health Tecna and built aircraft interiors. After returning to Grand Island, Tom worked in the ammunition department, building bombs for Vietnam. He also drove a milk truck and worked for Century Manufacturing. In 1992, he purchased TJ's Car Care, where he continued working until his passing. Tom was a member of the Masonic Temple. He loved anything to do with automobiles (Ford's especially) and racing. More than anything, he enjoyed spending time with his family.

Those left to cherish his memory include his wife, Barbara; children, Tammy (Chris) Ibsen of Littleton, CO, Thomas (Sonya) Townsley III of Grand Island;

six grandchildren; and six great grandchildren.

Tom was preceded in death by his parents; and siblings, Dale, Fern, Clayton, Robert, Margaret, Garry, Carol, And Patricia.
