Thomas John Wieck, 83, of Grand Island died Sunday, August 7, 2022 at Brookfield Park in St. Paul.

Mass of Christian Burial will be Thursday, August 18th at 1:00pm at Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church. Celebrating Mass will be Father Marty Egging. Private burial of ashes will be in the Grand Island Cemetery.
