Vera Hughes Lienert, 95 of Grand Island died on Tuesday, April 25, 2017. Private graveside service will be in the Harvard Cemetery. All Faiths Funeral Home is serving the family.

She was born at Belgrade, Nebraska in 1921, daughter of Frank and Jennie Hughes. She received her education in Belgrade, graduating in 1939.
