Warren L. Hudnall, 91 of rural Chapman, died Sunday, August 22, 2021 at CHI Health-St. Francis.

Warren was a member of the First Baptist Church of Chapman his entire life, serving as choir director for over 50 years. He sang at all of his children's weddings and most of his grandchildren's also. Any time he was asked to sing at a funeral or wedding he gladly did so. Warren lived a life of service by serving on the Chapman Cemetery Board for 70 years, Chapman School Board for many years serving terms as President, Farmers COOP Board, the Chapman Masonic Lodge, Grand Island City Singers and a member of the Liederkrantz.
