Warren D. Rodgers, 89 of Grand Island passed on Friday, December 17, 2021 at CHI Heath-St. Francis.

Warren was born on October 4, 1932 at Netawaka, Kansas the adopted son of Chester and Virginia (Sargent) Rodgers. He was raised in Falls City.

Following his graduation from high school, Warren graduated from Hastings College, did his graduate work at UNK, UNL and Phoenix Foreign Trade Language School. He served in the U.S. Army from 1956-58.

Warren taught school in Ogallala and Grand Island until 1974. He served as Project Director for Stuhr Museum for 30 years. Many will remember Warren for playing the organ at local churches for over 40 years. His music ministry included hundreds of weddings and funerals. He also was a speaker for the Nebraska Humanities Council. Warren was an avid reader of astronomy, history and space exploration.

On June 5, 1985, Warren was united in marriage to Dee Spencer.
