



## Wayne Frederick Huebner

May 29, 1929 - March 27, 2015

Wayne Frederick Huebner, 85, of Grand Island passed away at March 27, 2015 at CHI Saint Francis.

Service and celebration of Wayne's life will be 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Daniel Naranjo will officiate. Burial will be in Westlawn Memorial Park Cemetery.

Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. Tuesday at the funeral home.

Wayne was born May 29, 1929 in Grand Island to Fred C. and Minnie (Luth) Huebner.

Wayne graduated from Grand Island Senior High, Class of 1947. He played trombone in the band and continued with the Grand Island City Band for several years.

Beginning his work career with Union Pacific Railroad in the Grand Island shops as a Carman, Wayne transferred into engine service at the close of the Grand Island yards. He retired in 1991 as a locomotive engineer with more

than 44 years of service. Wayne was President of the UPRR Employee Club for 13 years.

Wayne proudly served nine years with Co. "H" 134th Infantry NE National Guard and had achieved a rank of 1LT at the time of his discharge. He was also a guard at Cornhusker Ammunition Plant for several years.

Wayne was united in marriage to Emma Mueller on April 19, 1954 in Kearney. They were active volunteers in several area care facilities, especially Tiffany Square, receiving a Silver Salute recognition in 2006 and Aksarben Good Neighbor Citation in 2001.

He was very proud of his family. He also enjoyed gardening, railroad memorabilia, polka dancing, coffee with friends at Burger King and occasionally played button accordion at dances.
