William "Bill" Lucas, 80, of Grand Island, passed away on Sunday, November 13, 2022. 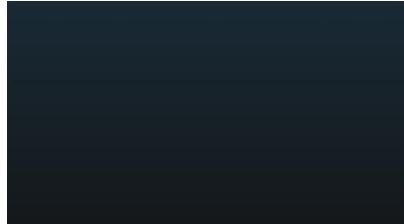
